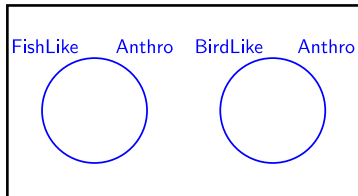
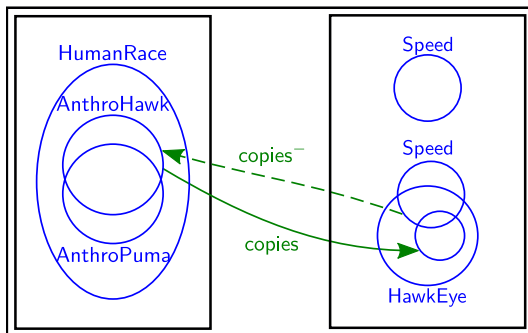


Examples with contradictions



- **FishLike** is equivalent to **Anthro**.
- **BirdLike** is equivalent to **Anthro**.
- No **FishLike** is **BirdLike**.

So no **Anthro** is **Anthro**. Thus nothing is an **Anthro**, nor **FishLike**, nor **BirdLike**.



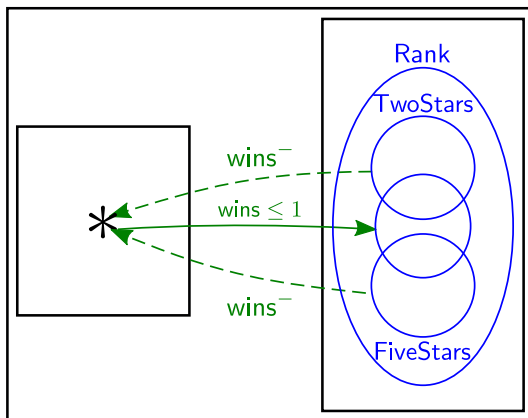
- **AnthroHawk** **copies** **only** **HawkEye**.
- **AnthroHawk** **copies** **at least one** **Speed**.

So **at least one** **Speed** is **HawkEye**. But

- No **Speed** is **HawkEye**.

Thus at least one of the following has to be true

- nothing is an **AnthroHawk**,
- nothing **copies** something.



- A thing **wins** **at least** **TwoStars**.
- A thing **wins** **at least** **FiveStars**.
- No **TwoStars** is **FiveStars**.
- All **TwoStars** are **Rank**.
- All **FiveStars** are **Rank**.

So the thing **wins** two different kinds of **Rank**, **TwoStars** and **FiveStars**. But

- A thing **wins** **only** **at most one** **Rank**.

Thus at least one of the following has to be true

- nothing is a **TwoStars**,
- nothing is a **FiveStars**,
- nothing **wins** something.
