



Examples with contradictions



- FishLike is equivalent to Anthro.
- BirdLike is equivalent to Anthro.
- No FishLike is BirdLike.

So no Anthro is Anthro. Thus nothing is an Anthro, nor FishLike, nor BirdLike.




- AnthroHawk copies only HawkEye.
- AnthroHawk copies at least one Speed.

So at least one Speed is HawkEye. But

- No Speed is HawkEye.

Thus at least one of the following has to be true

- nothing is an AnthroHawk,
- nothing copies something.



- A thing wins at least one TwoStars.
- A thing wins at least one FiveStars.
- No TwoStars is FiveStars.
- All TwoStars are Rank.
- All FiveStars are Rank.

So the thing wins two different kinds of Rank, TwoStars and FiveStars. But

- A thing wins only at most one Rank.

Thus at least one of the following has to be true

- nothing is a TwoStars,
- nothing is a FiveStars,
- nothing wins something.
